What we do:

We monitor the services daily and report back to Northern about any problems.

We regularly count the passengers using the trains so we have our own records, and don't just depend on figures from the Department for Transport.

We publish a quarterly Bulletin to keep members informed about the Lakes Line and its services. We campaign for better access to Staveley station, for a passing loop so we can have a train every half hour, and for the Lakes Line to be electrified.

We publicise the Lakes Line at local events using our Sales Stand, which also raises money for our campaigns.

What we have done:

Made sure the Lakes Line train waits at Oxenholme for a main line connection when the timetable allows; When the old Windermere station was sold, made sure it was replaced by a proper building fit for the gateway to the Lake District.

Persuaded British Rail to build a stone waiting shelter on Kendal station, rather than use a simple bus-stop shelter.



Friends of the Lakes Line (FoLL)

The FoLL are part of the LLRUG. Our aim is to make the stations more attractive places to arrive at and catch a train from. We have restored the plant beds at Kendal station, put up new tubs at Burneside and summer hanging baskets at Windermere station.
